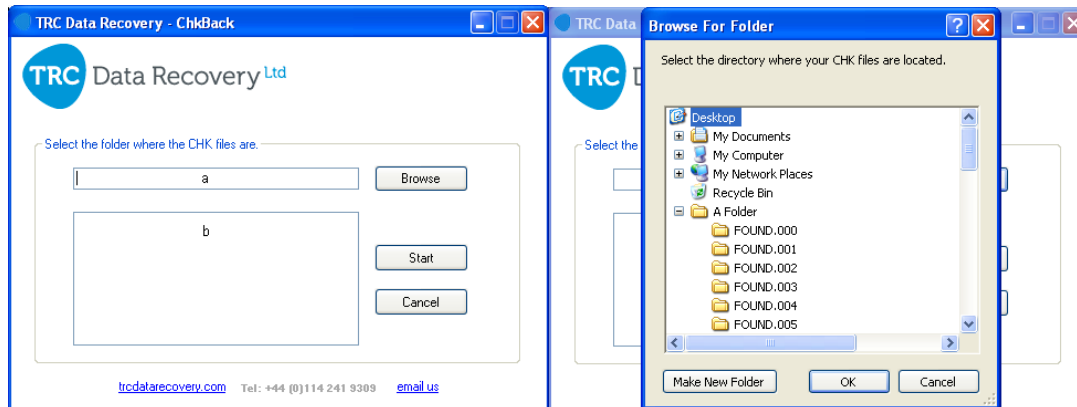


Chk-Back Instructions

Running Chk-Back is quite straightforward. After installation (click the link below to install) run the application and you will be given the following screen(s):

Click browse to navigate to the folder containing the Chk Files. When the folder is selected the path will be displayed in “a” and a list of the files within the folder will be displayed in “b”.

Click Start to begin the Chk-Back process. If there are no Chk file present in the selected folder the application will give a message and no further action will take place. If Chk files are found the application will interrogate each file to determine if its original format can be restored.



Each Chk file being tested is displayed as in the above with the file type displayed if found; if Chk-Back cannot determine the file type “unknown “ is displayed.

NOTE: Each Chk file is tested but not manipulated or changed in any way. If Chk-Back determines any file to be restorable a copy of that file is made in a sub folder labelled “ChkBack Results” with the correct file extension.

On completion of the scan the results are shown as follows:



A breakdown of the results is given along with the option to run again, save the result information to a text file or to terminate the application.
